CONTACT LENS AND REFRACTION SERVICES AND FEES:

Refraction: \$60.00 (APPLIES TO ALL PATIENTS)

A refraction consists of checking your visual acuity and determining the best optical correction needed for optimal visual function. This also includes a prescription for glasses. A glasses prescription is not considered to be part of a comprehensive eye exam and has a separate fee associated with it. **If you have vision insurance, refraction is a covered benefit. Medical insurances (including Medicaid) typically do not cover your refraction. You will be responsible for this fee.**

Contact Lens Evaluation (APPLIES TO CONTACT LENS WEARERS)

The evaluation and prescribing of contact lenses is considered a supplemental exam and is not included in the cost of your eye exam. Medical insurance does not cover the cost of a contact lens evaluation. Vision insurance plans vary and also may not cover the cost of an evaluation. Contact lens prescriptions are only valid for one year. Even if you are happy with your current contacts, they still must be re-evaluated and prescribed every year.

Current Contact Lens Wearers

The contact lens evaluation fee includes evaluating the vision in your current lenses to see if changes need to be made. The doctor checks to ensure your contacts fit properly and are not causing any ocular health complications. Fees also include trial lenses, if needed, and follow-ups within 90 days of your initial appointment. Any evaluation outside of 90 days will incur an additional fee. All specialty lenses come with a strict 90-120 day warranty for exchanges/returns. We will notify you at the time of your fitting if your lenses fall into that category.

Standard Spherical Lens: \$60.00

Multifocal, RGP and Monovision: \$75.00

Multifocal (New Wearers): \$150.00

Specialty Lenses: \$200.00-1000.00

Toric Lens: \$70.00

Duette (New Wearers): \$150.00

Duette (Current Wearers): \$65.00

First Time Wearers

In addition to the contact lens evaluation fee described above, new contact lens wearers must receive insertion and removal training by an eyecare professional. This includes teaching you how to properly insert and remove your contact lenses as well as how to clean/care for them. Contact lenses will not be dispensed until you can demonstrate proper lens insertion and removal.

Training fee: \$75.00
